LISA ROMERO is a practising homeopath and adult educator who has applied anthroposophy to her practice since 1990 and delivered education enriched with anthroposophy since 1998. Since 2006 the primary focus of her work has been teaching inner development and anthroposophical meditation and has written a book *“The Inner Work Path – A Foundation for Meditative Practise in the Light of Anthroposophy”*.



Lisa lectures and presents workshops and retreats on the inner work and anthroposophical meditation for professional and personal development. These are offered throughout the year in many communities within Australia, Asia and the United States. Lisa’s capacity to deliver esoteric wisdom with insight and understanding allows her to meet diverse needs of communities and professions.

She continues to teach in numerous trainings and seminars for several organisations.
